Before using Hasegawa Tripod ladders, please inspect your ladder thoroughly: No slippery substance such as grease, oil, mud, snow, water, paint etc. on the steps. The back adjustable leg can be opened and closed, extended and packed in smoothly. No visible damage such as \* If not, check for mud, dirt cracks or corrosion, or other substances and especially around the remove them completely. joints, welded parts, and parts that adjusts the back adjustable leg.
